## 6. Head Teacher's report

## PARENT COUNCIL PAYMENTS

• the Parent Council has agreed to pay for the back gate and the sliding glass windows for the office (so parents and others don't have to enter the school when just handing in letters and small parcels)

#### 7. Treasurer's report

- £ 35,287 total
